Fishing Loreto on the Baja, Mexico

I have dreamed of fishing the Sea of Cortez for many years, as it has the largest variety of marine species of fish of any sea in the world. Hearing stories of the great fishing for yellowtail tuna, wahoo, sailfish, roosterfish and a wide variety of big grouper and other bottom fish is what got my attention. I even flew down to Loreto to check it out, and found one of the cleanest cities I have ever visited in Mexico. It has a significant population of part-time American residents and has been catering to anglers for decades.

I have put together an adventure to Loreto that offers the opportunity to fish for many of the fish that inhabit the Sea of Cortez, and provides enough free time to sample some of the other activities that are available here. I have arranged for three days of guided fishing. On the third day it concludes with a beach barbeque and snorkeling outing for all of the anglers. If people want additional days of fishing they can book them with our guide service Loreto Land and Sea Tours. They can also assist our party with kayak rentals, bird watching tours and hikes to see the cave paintings.

We will be staying at the elegant La Mision Hotel, which is right across the street from the water and a short walk to the marina, where we depart on our fishing trips. It is short walk from La Mision to the "old town" shopping and dining district. There are many quality restaurants in the City of Loreto, and even a world famous steak house.

I hope you can join us on this adventure to Loreto. The weather is always warm, but not too hot, in the spring. The fishing will be terrific and there is plenty of time set aside to just relax by the pool, or experience more of what Loreto has to offer.
